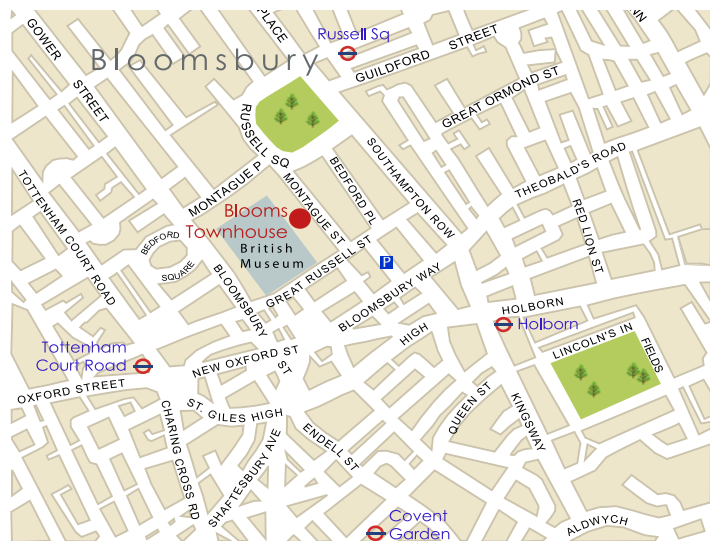

Nearest rail stations are Euston and Kings Cross / St. Pancras for Eurostar trains to Paris and Brussels.

By Tube

Nearest underground station is Russell Square, exit the station and turn left and walk towards Russell Square. After crossing the road turn left and walk across Russell Square. The 2nd left is Montague Street and the hotel is on the right hand side.

By Car

By road From the M40 continue along Marylebone Road, turn right into Upper Woburn Place, continue until Russell Square, turn right into Russell Square. The second left is Montague Street and the hotel is on the right.
